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Overview

Independence Pet Group, Inc., hereafter referred to as “IPG”, and together with its affiliates, (collectively referred to as “Company,” “we,” “us” or “our”) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your privacy, and the confidentiality and accuracy of your Personal Information.

This Privacy Policy explains how Personal Information will be collected, used, or disclosed. Your rights, obligations, and options regarding your Personal Information (defined below) are outlined herein. Throughout this policy, this website and all other affiliated websites will be referred to as the “Website” or “Websites”. Services provided by or enabled via the Websites will be referred to as the “Products” or “Services”. The term “Customer” also refers to anyone who might visit our Website(s) or purchase our Products and may be referred to collectively in this document as “you”, “your” or “yours”.

Through continued use of our Website and/or by completing a transaction with us, you authorize and consent to the processing of personal information as described in this Privacy Policy. This policy may change from time to time, and your continued use of our websites and services is deemed to be acceptable of such changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates. We are not responsible for the content or privacy practices of third-party sites to which this Website, or any other Website, may link.

What Personal Information Do We Collect?

“Personal Information” means information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular individual or household.

The information we may collect may include but is not limited to:

- First and Last name
- Address
- Email Address
- Telephone Number
- Unique numerical identifiers such as an IP address or mobile device identifier
- Geolocation or precise geolocation based on product capability
- Financial Information
- Information related to products and services purchased, data concerning website traffic and visits to the extent that such data is connected to a person’s personal information.
- Information regarding your dealings with us, including policy information, claims history, and premiums
- Audio, electronic visual, or other similar records

Personal Information does not include information anonymized through the removal of identifying details in a way that ensures the data can no longer be connected to an individual.

Your Personal Information and Insurance Products

If you purchase an insurance product from us, your Personal Information will be used to administer your insurance policy, and federal law requires that we disclose how your information is used, pursuant to the requirements outlined in the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA). A copy of this disclosure will be provided to you at the time of purchase.

Your Consent

Your consent may be obtained in various ways. We may obtain your express consent, or we may determine that consent has been implied by the circumstances. Express consent could be in writing, web forms, or verbally in person or over the phone. When we receive Personal Information from you through our Website, by phone or by mail that enables us to provide you with a requested Product or Service, you consent to allow us to deal with that Personal Information in a reasonable manner. Except in cases where consent is not legally required, we identify the reasons for the collection of your Personal Information.

It is important that you understand and consent to our collection, use, and disclosure of your Personal Information. We rely on the following actions by you as indications of your consent to our existing and future use of your Personal Information for identified purposes, until you notify us of a withdrawal of your consent:

- Your voluntary provision of Personal Information directly to us and our affiliates through our Website(s) in relation to one or more of our Services.
- Your consent is given through your authorized representative such as a legal guardian, agent, or holder of power of attorney.

By providing Personal Information about a third party such as a family member, emergency contact, or secondary owner by any of the above methods, you represent that you have obtained their consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of such Personal Information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

In the event you request changes, endorsements, renewals or other Products and Services, the original consent provided directly to us, or indirectly through a third party, will remain in effect. If our terms and conditions change, we will notify you at the time of change.

Why We Collect and Use Personal Information

Collecting Personal Information about you is essential to provide you with the Products and Services that best meet the needs of you and your pet. Your decision to withhold information may limit or affect the quality of service that we can provide to you. We collect, use, and disclose Personal Information (including to and from our affiliates and/or subsidiaries and/or third-party service providers / suppliers) for the following purposes:

- Offering and providing insurance quotes, policies, and related products and services to you.
- Administering and processing both insurance products and services, or their renewal.

- Ensuring policy holders obtain the appropriate services, discounts, and benefits in accordance with applicable terms.
- Establishing and maintaining communications with you.
- Verifying your identity and the accuracy of your personal information through, for example, the exchange of information with government agencies, industry associations, brokers, and other insurers.
- Analyzing, assessing, underwriting, and reinsuring insurance risks on a prudent basis.
- Determining and facilitating your payment of fees and insurance premiums.
- Investigating and settling insurance claims.
- Detecting and preventing fraud or other illegal activities.
- Compiling statistics and reporting to regulatory or industry entities in accordance with prudent insurance practices.
- Joint Marketing purposes.
- Gathering your feedback to help us improve our products and services.
- For the purposes of studies, aggregated analysis and audience grouping for marketing measurement and optimization, and identifying statistics, including to establish rates; to understand and analyze the interests, needs, and preferences of policyholders, prospective customers, and website visitors; to perform internal audits or verification; and to carry out products and services improvement activities.
- To develop, design, improve, market, or recommend products and services to respond to the needs and interests of current and prospective members and policyholders. We may also continue to market to you if you are no longer a customer.
- To communicate with you, respond to questions or complaints, requests for advice or other inquiries.
- Complying with the law or the requests of law enforcement agencies or regulators.
- For internal, external, and regulatory audit purposes.
- For the purposes of investigation and law enforcement.
- To send you marketing communications, and any offers on products or services that might be of interest to you.
- To recognize you and identify your preferences on our website, social media, email platforms, and mobile applications (as applicable), and to analyze their use, improve, and personalize their content.
- To communicate with you regarding any changes to our programs and their operations.

In this Privacy Policy, the above list of identified purposes will be referred to as “Identified Purposes.” We will not process or disclose your Personal Information to any third party, for any other purpose except as identified or permitted by law. If your Personal Information is used or disclosed for any purposes not related to the Identified Purposes, we will first obtain your consent for such purpose, except where prohibited by law.

How We Collect Personal Information

We may collect personal information from customers in several ways, including verbal, written, and electronic forms, through the Web, by telephone, mail, email, SMS (based on your consent, availability, and applicable terms), and chat (as available), through our authorized third-party service providers, affiliates, or otherwise, including but limited to, when you:

- Request or obtain a quote for pet insurance.
- Complete a transaction with us, our affiliate, or our business partners.
- Participating in our contests, promotional offers or receive discounts and benefits.
- Sign up or accept to receive newsletters, promotional and marketing emails, or other communications from us concerning our products, services, promotions, or events.
- Visit our website or social media platforms or interact with emails or online advertising. For more information, please review the Cookies and Digital Marketing section of this document.
- Contact, interact or communicate with one of our representatives to submit a request for service, remark, question, or complaint. In this regard, because some of our services are provided by telephone, the calls may be recorded to ensure the quality of our services and to protect both parties in the event of a disagreement.
- Participate in a survey or customer research by us.

When we receive personal information from you through our Website(s), by phone or by mail that enables us to provide you with a requested Product or Service, or to respond to a specific question, request, or complaint, you consent to allow us to deal with that personal information in a reasonable manner.

Pet Medical Information and Demographic Information

We obtain or share your pet's medical and/or demographic information only in connection with specific products and services. This may include underwriting a pet insurance policy, processing a claim or any other use that we disclose to you before the information is collected. We have implemented measures designed to secure your pet's medical information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure.

How Long Do We Keep Your Data

We will only collect, use, or disclose personal information that is necessary to provide products and services. We will retain your personal information only as long as necessary to satisfy our legal or business obligations, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, tax, accounting or reporting requirements.

Some of the factors considered when determining the appropriate retention period for personal information include the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal information processed, the potential risk of harm from any unauthorized use or disclosure of your personal information, the

purposes for which we process your information, and applicable legal and contractual requirements.

As explained in the “[How May I Make A Request](#)” section, you can request the deletion of your personal information. Once the purposes for processing the information have been fulfilled and personal information is no longer required, we will delete it. In some circumstances, we may permanently anonymize your personal information so that it can no longer be used to identify you in any way, in which case we may use the anonymized data without further notice to you.

How We Share Personal Information

To manage our products and services, we may share your information as allowed or required by law. We may share your information with our affiliates or third parties outside of the Company to service, market or underwrite our products and services to you. We rely on contractual agreements with affiliates, service providers, and third-party insurance agents and brokers which sell our products and services. Contractual agreements include requirements for the protection and limitation of usage of your information.

We may disclose personal Information that you provide via this website or mobile application to the following third parties:

- Our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- Contractors and service providers we use to support our business,
- Joint Marketing Agreements with non-affiliated third parties to jointly market insurance products and services.
- Veterinarians to assist with processing your claims.
- In the event of merger, acquisition, or any form of sale of some or all of our assets, in which case personal information held by us about our customers will be among the assets transferred to the buyer.
- We may also disclose your personal information to third parties to:
 - Comply with any court order or other legal obligation.
 - Enforce or apply our Terms of Use.
 - Protect the rights, property, or safety of us, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Independent Agents and Brokers

The independent insurance agents and brokers who sell our products and services are not our employees and are not subject to our privacy policy. Contact your agent or broker to learn more about their privacy practices.

Links to Other Websites

Our website contains links to other websites for informational or resource purposes. These other websites are not under our direct control, and they may collect information about you that we do not. We are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of linked websites. We encourage you to reference the privacy policies of third-party websites and / or mobile applications before providing any personal information to them.

Marketing and Other Communications

Social media: As an extension of our internet presence, we have social media accounts on Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, and TikTok, or others. The social media accounts of businesses are public, and therefore we recommend anyone who chooses to interact via social media should first read the terms of use and confidentiality and privacy policies of those platforms to inform themselves of how personal information is used by those platforms. Since all content posted on our social media accounts can be viewed publicly, we recommend users exercise caution when providing or disclosing personal information or details about themselves.

We offer content or discussions on our social media accounts, which, depending on your account settings, may allow us to access certain personal information associated with your social media account(s). We do not receive direct access to users' private social media account information. Any data shared with us is governed by the privacy settings and policies of the social media platform. We may also collect the date and time you visited the page for the purpose of sharing. We may use this information to confirm your identity and personalize your experience. We may also use the services provided by social media platforms to display targeted advertisements intended for the users of such platforms.

Email and advertising targeting: We strive to manage all email addresses responsibly and in compliance with applicable laws. Therefore, pursuant to express consent you have given us, or implied based on the circumstances, we may send you promotional messages by email, unless you unsubscribe from such emails.

To better understand and improve the effectiveness of our email marketing efforts, when we send you an email for marketing purposes, we collect information to assess the open rate and to know whether you clicked on the links in the email, and which of our websites you visited.

You may remove your name from our mailing list at any time by following the unsubscribe link displayed at the bottom of every advertising email from us. We will remove your name from our electronic mailing lists within 10 business days of your request. Note that unsubscribing from our commercial messages, certain specific situations such as invoicing or information about your policy or membership allow us to send you emails in accordance with the exceptions provided by law.

Text Communications: We may utilize text messaging, or SMS, communications and we strive to ensure compliance with all applicable laws for responsible SMS communication. Therefore, to receive SMS updates and promotions, we will ask for your express written consent before communicating with you. Message and data rates imposed by your mobile provider may apply. Text message opt-in originator will not be shared with affiliates or third parties for marketing purposes without your consent.

If you choose to opt-out of receiving promotional SMS communications, you may do so at any time by simply responding “STOP” to our messages or by clicking the unsubscribe link in the message. However, we may continue to periodically communicate with you via SMS for non-promotional matters. To opt-out of these messages, you can update your communication preferences in your profile.

Cookies and Digital Marketing

Our Websites may use certain automated tools including cookies, browser analysis tools, server logs, and web beacons to offer you a more customized browsing experience, to better recognize your needs, to follow trends, to target marketing initiatives and to offer you content that is more relevant to you. Third-party services may also be utilized to gather and analyze data about the areas visited on the websites (such as the page most frequented, time spent, search terms used and other engagement information) to further enhance the user experience.

Cookies: Our Websites utilize cookies. A cookie is a small file stored on your computer or other browser-enabled device. We use cookies to enhance our Websites, personalize the user experience, improve search speed, and identify when users revisit our Website. These cookies do not read data from your device or other websites’ cookies. You have the option to refuse cookies by selecting the appropriate setting within your browser. However, if you choose to select this setting, it may impact your ability to access certain parts of our Websites.

Targeted data made available by digital marketing service providers: We could also utilize services provided by third-party platforms e.g., Search and social media to present targeted advertisements, based on the user data collected by such platforms. In general, the way you engage with and receive advertisements on those platforms is governed by each platform's respective privacy policy, terms of use, and preference options. We may also sometimes use the third-party platforms to offer users more targeted advertising, based on multiple factors such as the platform's user data and interactions with us outside of the platform, as applicable.

Web Beacons: Website pages may contain electronic images known as web beacons or single-pixel gifs which allow us to count visiting users as well as record.

Usage Details and IP Addresses: While you navigate around our Website, we may also collect information about your visit, including, but not limited to: traffic and location data and logs, other communication data resources that you access, as well as information about your device and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate data to our advertisers. This is considered statistical data and does not identify any individual.

You may opt out of tracking cookies or control how information collected by cookies is used through your browser or using the cookie widget on the Website(s), or the "Do Not Sell or Share My Personal Information" link on the Website(s).

We do not collect personally identifiable information automatically, but we may tie any information collected through cookies to information you may have previously submitted. Google Analytics provides tools to opt out of their services. How Do We Protect Your Data

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of your

personal information transmitted to our website or mobile application. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk.

International Transfer

Our Company is based in the United States and the information we and our Service Providers collect is governed by U.S. law. If you are accessing the Service from outside the U.S., please be aware that information collected through the Service may be transferred to, processed, stored, and used in the U.S. Data protection laws in the U.S. may be different from those of your country of residence. California Notice at Collection

This California Notice at Collection explains how Independence Pet Group, Inc., hereafter referred to as “IPG”, and together with its affiliates, (collectively referred to as “Company,” “we,” “us” or “our”) collects, uses, retains, and discloses personal information **relating only to California residents** who are subject to the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA), as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA).

California consumers may be entitled to certain notices and disclosures regarding the collection, use, and sharing of their personal information, rights to access, correction, and deletion of certain personal information we collect about them, restricts us from “selling” or “sharing” certain personal information, and limit our use of sensitive personal information as applicable and defined by the law and described in the categories below. These rights apply to all residents of California, regardless of whether you are a customer, website visitor, business contact, or an employee. As a California resident, you have a right not to receive discriminatory treatment for exercising your privacy rights. What is Personal Information?

Under the CCPA, “Personal Information” is information that identifies, relates to, or could reasonably be linked with a particular consumer or household. We collect Personal Information relating to California users in a variety of contexts. The specific Personal Information that we collect, use, disclose, sell or share depends on our relationship or interaction with that individual.

Categories of Third Parties to Whom We Disclose Personal Information

- Our subsidiaries and affiliates for the purposes of management, analysis, or other business purposes.
- We use Service Providers and Contractors to support our business, for example, legal service, marketing or other creative or promotional agencies, information technology services and products, cloud-based services, web hosting, Service Providers or Contractors.
- Third-Party Data Analytics Providers.
- Advertising Networks for cross-context advertising purposes
- Internet service providers
- Regulatory bodies, as required by law, comply with legal obligation or to protect our rights and interests.

Sale, Sharing, and Other Disclosures of Personal Information

Any category of personal information listed in the chart below may be shared for a business purpose with service providers and contractors, which are companies that we engage to conduct activities on our behalf. Service providers and contractors are restricted from using personal information for any purpose not related to our engagement.

California law requires us to provide you with information regarding the parties to whom we “sell” or “share” your information, and the parties to whom we disclose your information for a business purpose. A business “sells” personal information when it discloses Personal Information to another business or a third party for monetary or other valuable considerations.

Under CCPA, allowing certain third parties to collect Personal Information via automated technologies on our website for cross-context advertising purposes is considered the “sharing” of your Personal Information. We do not have actual knowledge that we sell or share the Personal Information of minors under 16 years of age.

Our Company sells or shares the categories of personal information listed in the chart below for advertising and analytics with social media platforms, advertising networks, and Third-Party data analytics providers.
